#### This Sunday! Workshop on Advance Directives, July 16 at St. Martin's

Caring Ministries is offering an information session on Advance Directives today, Sunday, July 16 after the 10am service. Louise Joyce from Yolo Cares will facilitate. Advance Care Planning is the process by which you consider what matters most to you if you become seriously ill—what medical treatments you want or don't want, where you want to be at the end of your life, and how you want the end of your story to go. This process is not just for older adults; unexpected medical situations can occur at any age.

#### **Sunday Bible Study Continues after 10am Service**

The first readings from the Lectionary for June, July and August 2023 mainly feature stories from the book of Genesis. We will gather after coffee hour each Sunday July 9 – August 27 to discuss these often puzzling, foundational stories in the Judeo-Christian tradition. Bring a brown bag lunch or just a coffee and an extra cookie. Drop-ins are welcome. Vestry member Colette Chabbott will facilitate the discussion.

#### Join Us at Picnic in the Park, Wednesday, July 19, 5pm

On Wednesday, July 19, from 5pm - 8pm you are invited to join a group of St. Martin's parishioners at Picnic in the Park. Come for a few minutes or a few hours. The City of Davis has revived the summer tradition of gathering downtown on Wednesday evenings to enjoy the Farmers' Market, live music, food trucks and each other's company. Central Park fills up with dogs, children, hula hoops, lawn games, musical instruments and friends just hanging out. Bring your own food and drink or pick them up from onsite vendors. We will try to snag a picnic table in a handicapped accessible area near the NW corner of the park; look for a bright tablecloth or maybe even a banner. Table seating will be limited, so bring folding chairs or a picnic blanket if you can. Parking is limited but not impossible.

#### **Eagle Scout Project at the Ranch**

We welcome Tyler Staub, who is doing his Eagle Scout project at Forbes Ranch where he is creating a bee and butterfly garden. He chose the Ranch location, in consultation with us, as he was looking for a large area of full sun. Tyler raised \$570 at St. Martin's last Sunday (thank you, St. Martin's!) and this combined with other monies he has raised totals \$1,295. He is still hoping to raise additional funds as he anticipates spending \$3,500 on topsoil, decomposed granite, plants, informational sign and a sitting bench. This Sunday, he will be at the 8am service, but you can stop by his table after either service at church to hear the details!
