AED Installed in Church

St. Martin's received a grant to purchase an automated external defibrillator (AED) device and to train people to use it. The AED is located in a white box in the back of the church to the left of the doors leading from the church to the narthex. So far, eight parishioners, including vestry, choir members and parishioners at large, have received Red Cross training to use the equipment and perform CPR.
