John 1:1-18

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through him, and without him not one thing came into being. What has come into being in him was life, and the life was the light of all people. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it.

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him. He himself was not the light, but he came to testify to the light. The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world.

He was in the world, and the world came into being through him; yet the world did not know him. He came to what was his own, and his own people did not accept him. But to all who received him, who believed in his name, he gave power to become children of God, who were born, not of blood or of the will of the flesh or of the will of man, but of God.

And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of grace and truth. (John testified to him and cried out, "This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes after me ranks ahead of me because he was before me.") From his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace. The law indeed was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. No one has ever seen God. It is God the only Son, who is close to the Father's heart, who has made him known.

The Candidate for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

Presenters We present Sydney Isheanesu Kuodza to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

### The Presider asks the presenters

Will you be responsible for seeing that the child you present is brought up in the Christian faith and life?

- *Presenters* I will, with God's help.
- *Presider* Will you by your prayers and witness help this child to grow into the full stature of Christ?
- *Presenters* I will, with God's help.

Then the Presider asks the following questions of the presenters

- QuestionDo you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?AnswerI renounce them.
- QuestionDo you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?AnswerI renounce them.
- QuestionDo you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God?AnswerI renounce them.
- QuestionDo you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Savior?AnswerI do.
- QuestionDo you put your whole trust in his grace and love?AnswerI do.
- QuestionDo you promise to follow and obey him as your Lord?AnswerI do.

### Now the Presider addresses the congregation, saying

Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support this person in his life in Christ?PeopleWe will.

### The Presider

Let us join with he who is committing himself to Christ and renew our own baptismal covenant.

### THE BAPTISMAL COVENANT

Presider People	Do you believe in God the Father? I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.
Presider People	Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God? I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.
Presider People	Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit? I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.
Presider People	Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of the bread, and in the prayers? I will, with God's help.
Presider	Will you persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever you fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord?
People	I will, with God's help.
Presider People	Will you proclaim by word and example the Good News of God in Christ? I will, with God's help.
Presider People	Will you seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving your neighbor as yourself? I will, with God's help.
Presider People	Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being? I will, with God's help.

In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John and was anointed by the Holy Spirit as the Messiah, the Christ, to lead us, through his death and resurrection, from the bondage of sin into everlasting life.

We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.


