Trinity Sunday and Baptism: Today, we celebrate Trinity Sunday! At the 10am service, we baptize Juliane Bryan and welcome her into the household of God.

Today's Offertory anthem, "Achieved is the Glorious Work," from "The Creation" by Franz Josef Haydn, was selected in praise and thanks to mark the end of our first program year with professional Section Leaders in the choir. We are grateful for Zoe Schuck, Samuel Peters, Gavin Pinnow, and Daniel Ostrom, and to the funding which makes their participation possible. Daniel will be leaving us to pursue his academic studies in southern California; our Communion anthem, "Lead Me, Lord," was selected with his voice in mind. Jeffrey's Prelude is a Passacaglia by James Woodman, representing Pentecost and the Trinity.
